

Terms and conditions

1. Proposals should contain, detail work plan and breakup of expenditure, full profile of the applicant/Organization along with experience to the related works..
2. Proposal should be submitted based on the above mentioned budget.
3. Separate proposals should be submitted for each project.
4. Proposals will be scrutinized and selected by an expert Committee under Tribal Research and Cultural Institute.
5. In case a project is entrusted to a person/NGO, the entrusted Organization/persons need to present a midterm report. The mid term report and the final report will be scrutinized by the Expert committee and the concerned person/NGO are liable to make necessary correction or modification as suggested by the committee.
6. 40% of the sanctioned fund will be released as an 1st Instalment. 30% will be released as 2nd Instalment after satisfactory presentation of mid term report. Remaining 30% will be released after satisfactory and successful completion of the work. In case the project is not Completed successfully, then the 70% of the total fund which would be given as 1st instalment and 2nd Instalment should be refunded to Tribal Research and Cultural Institute.
7. All the assets acquired from the sanctioned amount will be the property of Tribal Research and Cultural Institute and should not be disposed off or encumbered or utilised for purpose other than those for which the grant would be sanctioned. The researcher/NGOs are required to send to the Tribal Research and Cultural Institute a list of assets acquired from the grant.
8. The project should be completed within stipulated time limit as mentioned above. 3(Three) hard copies of the report along with soft copy should be submitted during final submission.
9. The final report will be published by this institute. The report or part of the report cannot be utilized or published without prior permission of Tribal Research and Cultural Institute.
10. Researchers/organisations who will be entrusted for the work are required to sign an agreement including above terms and conditions with Tribal Research and Cultural Institute before taking up of the work.
